 - Plan discussed with Board members & approved as presented
 - Next year there will be a new 5-year plan
- Jail Funding
 - Resolution to accept additional funding specifically for the MAT program being presented
 - Funding to be sent to the Jail
 - \$8,000 annual funding per year going forward
 - Meeting with Captain Yaeger on Monday regarding over-runs in Medicaid Assisted Treatment and how to pay for it
 - 1st Quarter billing for 2025 is over \$4,000
 - Met with Trinity & Jail to determine over-run reason
 - Per Dr. Nichols tablets & strips are more economic and safer than injectables
 - Lori will follow up with the above points at the next meeting
- Staffing
 - Lousie Henley, CSW starting in Owego 7/14/25
 - Candidate found for the Mental Health Crisis Worker position
 - Resolution in July to downgrade a Senior position to fill this vacancy

- Individual is very qualified
- Mobile Crisis
 - Additional extension was requested to roll funding into 2026
 - o Two vehicles purchased with funding
 - o Approximately \$500,000 in funding left for the program
 - o Continued concerns over sustainability
 - o Crisis worker could be used in different ways to make position sustainable
 - o Will have a Mental Health Peer eventually
- Budget
 - Nothing unexpected regarding directives
 - New: vacancies over 12 months need to be justified as to why it is a need
 - Vacant CASAC position being filled by Porshea Moore in August
- Active Shooter Trainings
 - o Training taking place in June & August
 - Mandatory for all county employees
- DFC, CARA. & STOP ACT Grants
 - Could be at risk for cuts
 - Wait and see the situation
